



# PRESIDENTS REPORT

With SLSNSW's Covid vaccine mandates and restrictions in place again from the beginning of the 2021-22 season along with unseasonal weather including record rainfalls, floods and storm damage throughout the summer, the season was one of the most challenging for the club, its members and the public that can be remembered in recent times!

As always, our patrols, volunteers and members met these challenges head on and continued to protect the public and maintain a community presence, whilst embracing and working hard to improve, grow and build the club facilities, presence, and capability further with the continual guidance, efforts and commitment of the committee and its active members.

Even with the unprecedented poor weather over the summer, our patrolling members have completed 4500 hrs of volunteer patrols, even with the beach closed more than normal and hence only 30+ rescues were carried out, a positive outcome considering the 2500 preventions and first aids the club usually performs each season. Once again, all patrolling members and their diligence and dedication must be acknowledged.

This season our training and education team, led by Lara McIntyre and Gary Hyland, continue to recruit nipper parents and willing adults into the club patrols with a further sixteen (16) bronze and four (4) SRC active members now qualified with these awards to fully join our patrols for the 22-23 summer season alongside a number of active members also gaining First aid IRB driver and crew Qualifications as the club strives towards increasing skilled lifesavers to bolster our patrol numbers.

Junior development and education has been a major part of the activity at Soldiers Beach over the 2021/22 season and with the fantastic efforts and efficient guidance from our junior development director, Jodie Freeman, our nipper activities and event schedules despite the poor weather, continued to be "best in class" with increased engagement of parents, age manager participation and a well-structured and skills focussed training program that will benefit the club in regards to nipper growth for many years to come.

The clubs winter board and swim skills training continues to be a success and is now integral part of the clubs junior development program. Jodie Freeman, Rachel Howieson and the rest of the Junior Development team, parents and the coaches are to be congratulated for this success.

Our senior competitors have represented Soldiers at all carnivals this season including Interclub (State titles having been cancelled due to poor conditions everywhere) and Australian titles, where Gold medals were won in both board & ski events along with our boat crews success. These events will continue to be a key engagement tool for the club to attract more patrolling members and encouraging increased carnival participation as the club looks to bring additional professional and experienced trainers and talent into the mix to assist our competitors hopefully over the next few seasons.

On the Administration front, Soldiers is starting to see an improved financial position as a result from the previous restructure of its commercial operations, and along with the committees key focus on continuing to reduce our operating costs, along with tight controls, accountability and transparent policies implemented by the club, due credit must be given to the executive in particular, Ellen Van Wessel, Shana Doughney and Craig Andrews along

with the committee and others including Coral Raymond, Emma Dennis and Gail Rixom for maintaining these high standards and managing the club budgets accordingly.

The Management Committee, in particular Matt Keys in conjunction with the SLSA Grants Unit has been instrumental in driving charity events and securing a number of grants for the club worth just over \$70,000 to date, which includes a \$30k solar grant in June this year to ensure the continued reduction of our club operating expenses and the urgent updating of our surf lifesaving equipment.

We are also excited to welcome another major sponsor - Toukley Rotary, who have come on board for the next 12 months to assist the club to update urgently needed Surf lifesaving equipment. The club, committee and members fully appreciate the ongoing support from all our sponsors and looks forward to more involvement from new and present sponsors in the seasons ahead.

The club administration continues to maintain active lines of communication with club stakeholders including SLSCC, SLSNSW and the local community. Soldiers has actively fostered its relationship with Central Coast Council and continues to work with Council across several fields including facilities management, public access and community engagement.

As the club looks forward to next year, there are several promising indicators for the continued success of Soldiers Beach SLSC on the back of the 2020/21 season. The club continues to engage and retain members, a marked increase in nipper participation and the commercial operations of the club continue to support the club operations with ongoing and renewed interest in club participation by the previous and new members!

Despite a rough and challenging season for all concerned, the club is taking positive steps towards a fantastic summer season in 2022-23 and once again, I would like to personally thank the committee, active patrol members and all associate members for their support and assistance throughout the year!

# DIRECTOR OF FINANCE REPORT

Thank you for the opportunity to be part of the committee of Soldiers Beach Surf Life Saving Club for the last four seasons. The club was in a terrible financial situation due to mismanagement, lack of understanding of basic principles of club management as well as terrible partnerships with the function room / restaurant and the kiosk.

The club was effectively under Administration being closely monitored by Surf Life Saving Central Coast. This was required due to the out of court settlement to the leaseholders of the kiosk of over \$100 000.

Under the leadership of Jim Buckton and Phil Walls the club has been able to repay debts to Wyong Leagues Club, Surf Life Saving Central Coast, Surf Life Saving NSW, Energy Australia, Central Coast Council and several other suppliers. We have also put in new partners / lease holders in contracts vetted by the Surf Life Saving Australian legal team – Thank You to Ian Fullagar for his invaluable advice and assistance.

The club needs active patrolling members urgently, the patrolling of the beach and provision of water safety to the local community is at the forefront of our activities. We provide outstanding education and training to our members. The future of the club depends on the members who know what it is like to get their feet on the sand and provide the thankless community service that is required. Surf Life Saving Central Coast provides fantastic leadership and resources to assist in sound club management. The future of the club is with the youth membership.

Recruitment and Retention must become a priority to ensure success into the future.

Congratulations to Lara McIntyre and Ellen Van Wessel for their untiring commitment to the club, if the club had more members with their attitude we would be back amongst the top clubs on the coast. Emma Dennis our Bookkeeper / Financial Controller provides fantastic service, sound advice when required and chases up our debts and when things were at our lowest put in place payment plans, and worked with the club on prioritisation of the overwhelming debts. Thank you Emma for your commitment to our club.

# DIRECTOR OF SURF LIFE SAVING REPORT

This season saw us once again start with just 6 patrols and 61 rostered members with an average of 116 rostered hours for the season. This equated to a minimum of 26 patrols for each member, a demanding schedule which allowed for only 1 weekend break every 2 weeks. Our patrolling members were also further stretched by the challenges of patrolling in the middle of another lockdown and with continued public health measures.

In addition to medical challenges and absences, our members were also faced with unprecedented environmental challenges which saw our beach closed a total of 92 days of our 2021/2022 season due to dangerous surf, pollution and erosion. The latter also resulted in us having minimal access to our beach and no opportunity to get our IRB onto the beach to assist in lifesaving operations if needed for most of the last portion of the season.

This season, as in the past, our operations have been supported by SLNSW and SLISA with a number of support mechanisms such as the Beach Safety Equipment Fund and the Club Lifesaving Equipment Grant. This season saw our club gain (for next season) 5 new rescue boards, 11 Personal Flotation Devices (safety jackets) for use in the IRB, and also an array of sun safety equipment which we look forward to using in the upcoming season. The success of these grants can also be attributed to the tireless effort of our Admin Director Ellen Van Wessel.

With this season's beach closures and unfortunate weather our patrol statistics were lower than previous years but our member numbers saw some growth with the largest increase being in the "active members above 18 years" category. This is exciting for the future of the club and largely due to the time and effort of the Education team. At the end of the season members were surveyed with regards to their thoughts and feedback for improving the patrol experience and there are some great ideas for improvements for next season, so we look forward to continuing to increase our numbers as well as member satisfaction in the upcoming season.

At this stage we still await our lifesaving agreement from SLNSW so that we can meet with SLSCC and Central Coast Council and discuss our patrol schedule for upcoming seasons. It is the hope that we can come to an agreement which best suits our members but allows us to continue to ensure the safety of all attendees to our beach.

With the conclusion of the 2021/22 season, we must acknowledge the immense time, effort and passion of our patrolling members and congratulate you all on your dedication which resulted in another successful season at Soldiers Beach. The future of our club and the safety of the patrons to our beach is in good hands.

# DIRECTOR OF EDUCATION REPORT

The 2021/22 season has been unsettling and challenging for the Education Team with uncertainty around the ongoing presence and management of COVID-19 and very unfavorable weather conditions which really presented a challenge with water-based training. Unfortunately, like last season the impact and uncertainty regarding COVID-19 pervaded all aspects of the education portfolio. And the ripples from State, to Branch to Club level were felt. I would like to take this opportunity to thank our members for their ongoing support.

This was our second season with the new curriculum for the Bronze Medallion (BM) and Surf Rescue Certificates (SRC). We were able to apply our leanings from last season and were able to better meet the challenges with the team in allocation of days and the new process. Issues around ongoing Trainer Assessor Facilitator (TAF) requirements remained unresolved but were addressed near the end of the season. Unfortunately, this season we did not get the required numbers to run a Parent Surf Rescue Certificate (SRC) course. However, we will try again next season and aim to advertise this much earlier so people are able to have the time need to train for this course.

We continued allocating people to a Patrol from the beginning of the course. Whilst on Patrol the candidates were able to learn as they went from the Patrol members. This enabled the candidates to connect with their Patrol at the start of the course, apply Patrol related activity to the learning and get a better appreciation of the reality of Patrolling as opposed to going onto Patrol at the end of the course and then trying to develop relationships with their Patrol. These relationships are already formed and beginning to embed.

We had planned to facilitate, train and assess two Bronze Medallion courses and two SRC courses and succeeded in this goal. It was also planned for an Inflatable Rubber Boat (IRB) Crew course which we were able to complete with the assistance of Shelley Beach who were able to take our members through their paces for IRB Crew and Driver. There are plans in place, with the ongoing assistance of Shelley Beach SLSC, to develop our own IRB Crew Trainer and to conduct an IRB Crew Winter course. A First Aid course was arranged by Soldiers and held at the Canton Beach Sports Club, who have been able to provide us a great training venue throughout the season and we are extremely grateful to them for their ongoing support. A First Aid Certificate course was also held by Branch. To provide support to our own community a First Aid course was delivered by our team to the Toukley Neighbourhood Centre team.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank all those who make themselves available to the Education Team and willingly share their skills and experience with our students. It really adds

to the quality of the courses to have such experience readily available. And a big thank you to all those who have helped with water safety, scenario training, swim and board training.
